Each Night At Awana

At Awana kids will play exciting games, learn Bible truths, memorize Scripture, and are challenged to live lives that honor God. Awana meets on Wednesday nights from August to April. Clubbers may start checking-in at 6:45pm and at 7:00pm we begin the night with a flag ceremony in the gym. Club ends at 8:30pm.

What To Bring

Dues (\$15 for the year or 50¢ each week)

Entrance Booklet or Handbook

A desire to learn, have fun, and cooperate!

Please help your child have a safe night by ensuring that they are wearing the proper footwear for our exciting game time. **Tennis shoes are required for this fast paced and active time. Please, no flip flops.** Kids may have to sit out from games if they do not have appropriate footwear.

Transportation

There is a bus that leaves from the Memorial Hospital parking lot at 6:15.

It returns between 8:45-8:50. Please be prompt.

How To Prepare

Help your child prepare for club each week by learning the handbook material at home. A brief, 5 minute session each morning or evening works very well. Be sure to complete the sections in order. Children should be prepared to recite a memory section without looking at it.

Cooperation & Discipline

Children are expected to respect and cooperate with the club leadership. If a child does not cooperate, they are given 3 warnings. Should they receive a 3rd warning, they will lose the privilege to attend club the following week. The Club Commander will contact you in this event.

Cost

We ask each clubber to bring .50 cents for weekly dues. This helps us pay for awards, prizes, and special events. We really appreciate your help in sending dues to club with your child. If you prefer, dues may be paid in advance for the entire year or half-year:

Handbook Hints

PASSING SECTIONS

First Time through handbook

1. Child recites verse and reference to leader, and any other requirements listed in "to finish this section."
2. Child may have two helps per section.

Second Time through handbook

1. Bible verse and reference must be recited word-perfect, with no helps.

Tips On How Parents Can Help

1. Please bring your child to club on time (before 7:00 p.m.) If they arrive after flag ceremony they will receive points for attendance only.
2. Make sure your clubber wears their uniform to club. Proper display of clubbers awards contributes greatly to their sense of achievement.
3. Help your child prepare for Club each week, learning handbook material at home. A brief 5 minute session each morning or evening works very well. Be sure to complete the sections in order. Sparks should complete 2-3 sections a week. **T&T will move together with their group, through their books, completing 1 section a week. T&T youth working to catch up with their group can ONLY say 2 additional sections at a time/ during club.**
4. Visit club anytime. Your child will be thrilled to have you take part in club activities.
5. Encourage your child each step of the way. Learning is hard work!
